“Planting and Producing”

Saved by God’s Grace for God’s Glory

Proverbs 4:7 *“Wisdom is the principal thing; Therefore get wisdom. And in all your getting, get understanding”*

In Luke 8, Jesus spoke a parable about planting (sowing) and producing to a large crowd from various cities. They came from different social and cultural conditions and circumstances. He spoke of a planter but His focus was on the proper planting of the seed (Word of God-v11). As he sowed, the seeds fell (v4-8MSG):

- I. On the road; it was tramped down and the birds ate it (no production). The enemy comes like a falcon to manipulate our mind so the word won’t take root in our heart. He doesn’t care if we believe. He wants to prevent us from becoming.
- II. In the gravel; it sprouted, but withered because it didn’t have good roots (some production). We hear the word, receive the word and believe the word but lose momentum in the private moments. When temptation comes, we stray from what we believe. The enemy wants you to feel disqualified to be in the presence of God because he knows public image reflects private integrity (v17).
- III. In the weeds; the thorns grew with it and strangled it (temporary production). We are prepared to go out and produce but get disturbed by the cares of this world. The heightened risk of poverty, crime and chaos can lead to vulnerability. The enemy desires to disturb us. In the midst of the storm, take your eyes off the rain and keep your eyes on the road. We cannot allow the enemy to distract us from our destiny.
- IV. In rich earth (Holy ground) and produced. We are no longer deceived into thinking that we could hear the word and never manifest the word (James 1:22). Thus, producing good fruit fit for the kingdom.
