“Road to Recovery”

Proverbs 4:7 *“Wisdom is the principal thing; Therefore get wisdom. And in all your getting, get understanding”*

Do you currently experience mental road rage? Is it all mapped out in your mind but you still don’t know which direction will lead to divine destiny? Are you so consumed with the past that you have no control of your present or fail to concentrate on your future? It’s time to get ambitious about your assignment and stop sabotaging your success. It’s imperative that you know who and what is driving you to your destiny. God designed driving directions that will help you recover from whatever has you bound (Proverbs 3:6 CEV). Let’s examine a few road signs:



We are all guilty of making excuses. We must rid ourselves from those excuses that have become acceptable. We’ve made them for so long that they have become our truths. In Exodus 4 we learn of the many excuses Moses made. Moses pleaded with God to use someone else and it made God angry but it didn’t stop God from using him to deliver His people from bondage. God sent someone to help and He said “I will teach you what you shall do” (v15). God did great signs in the sight of the people and the people believed! We have to stop making excuses and start depending on God so that others may believe.

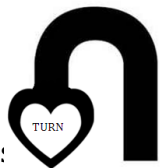
Moses said “suppose they will not believe me or listen to my voice; suppose they say....” (v1). The reality is; *they* will always have something to say. Who are they? What excuses have become your truths based on what they say? “I am not....” (v10). What excuses have you made based on who you think you’re not?

“I AM WHO I AM” (Exodus 3:14)

Romans 12:2 “. . . be transformed by the renewing of your mind, that you may prove what is that good and acceptable and perfect will of God.”



There are some places in your past that you shall never dwell again. God called you out and destroyed it. That’s what God did when he destroyed Sodom and Gomorrah due to its wickedness (Genesis 19:1-29). Lot was instructed to take those that were with him and get out of that place. When he sons-in-law, they thought he was joking. The angels urged Lot not to get consumed in the punishment of others. Lot hesitated but the Lord showed mercy and provided an escape. They were instructed not to look back. Lot’s wife disobeyed, looked back and turned into a pillar of salt. Today, when we disobey, it creates sadness, adversity, lies (deceit), and turmoil. It’s good to reflect back on events that will help you grow because you have learned valuable lessons from the experience. However, there are certain people, places and emotional ties that you’ve been warned not to return to. Read Philippians 3:12-14.



We often take the wrong turn in life. YOU-Turns can be frustrating but Change is only Complicated until its Complete! Sometimes when we encounter roadblocks, we fail to receive the lesson. God’s roadmap allows you to make you-turns and sincerely turn back to Him. The only person who can stop you numbers 22, Balaam appears to be a man who follows God. Balaam asked for God’s permission. God clearly stated “You shall not go...” However, when they raised the offer, Balaam displayed the heart of a hireling and asked God again. God allowed him to go with specific instructions. God gave him an opportunity to turn back to Him. Balaam’s donkey warned him three times. GOD’s angel said to him: *“I have come here to block your way because you’re getting way ahead of yourself. The donkey saw me and turned away from me these three times. If she hadn’t, I would have killed you by this time...”* (v32-33MSG). Take heed to the voice of God. When He makes a donkey speak, He’s trying to get your attention.
