“Triumphant Entry”

Palm Sunday is one of the most important days for Christians perhaps behind Christmas and Easter. Palm Sunday is the Sunday before Easter and marks the beginning of the Holy Week. The Holy week (also known as Passion Week) is the time from Palm Sunday through Easter Sunday and when Jesus revealed his true passion for us through his willingness suffer on our behalf. It was on Palm Sunday that the triumphant entry of Jesus into Jerusalem on a donkey took place as prophesied (predicted or indicated beforehand through God) in Zechariah 9:9 which states “Rejoice greatly, O daughter of Zion! Shout, O daughter of Jerusalem! Behold, your King is coming to you; He *is* just and having salvation, Lowly and riding on a donkey, A colt, the foal of a donkey.” During this time, some people spread their garments while others spread palm branches along the path that Jesus rode on in order to welcome him. The palm branches are a symbol of victory and the laying of palm branches indicated that the king or any other person holding a high office or position was arriving in victory or triumph. As a matter of fact, Jesus is the King of kings and he is most worthy to be praised much like he was when he entered into Jerusalem. Some of the people praised him by saying “Blessed is He Who comes in the Name of the Lord; Hosanna in the highest.” (Matthew 21:9b)

You must know that if you are connected to Jesus then you can have the victory through him. Jesus is the one who provides you with victory over anything that may try to defeat you, bring you down, or destroy you. If there is some problem, issue, situation, temptation that you think that you can't overcome, just remember that you can overcome it through Jesus in whom victory is always guaranteed. This is your time of **VICTORY** so embrace it.
