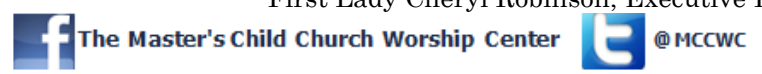

You were created by God with a unique purpose. It can hurt when people say bad things about you but you must know who you are and whose you are in Christ. *"...But as many as received Him, to them He gave the right to become children of God"* John 1:12. Don't be defined by what people say about you. We live in a world where teasing, name calling and bullying have become acceptable. But it's NOT acceptable. You're not having an identity crisis, you just need to know the Christ-list (who God expects you to be). Always remember that you are a child of God!

Caring for God's People

Did you know...

A mirror's primary purpose is to reflect light, but mirrors are most commonly used to view our own reflection. Our reflection should be a reflection of light. Mirrors faithfully reflect the actual image of what appears before it. Genesis 1:27 says that God created you in His own image. What do you see when you look into a mirror? You should see a unique gift that God has given the world. What you see as imperfections make you unique and stand out as special to God. Mirrors that are used in vehicles help people see what's coming behind them, beside them and to also avoid crashing. Use your mirror to see what's coming up inside you to avoid behaviors that may cause you to crash spiritually. You are a mirror of the chosen generation that is coming behind you, so reflect good choices and great character.
