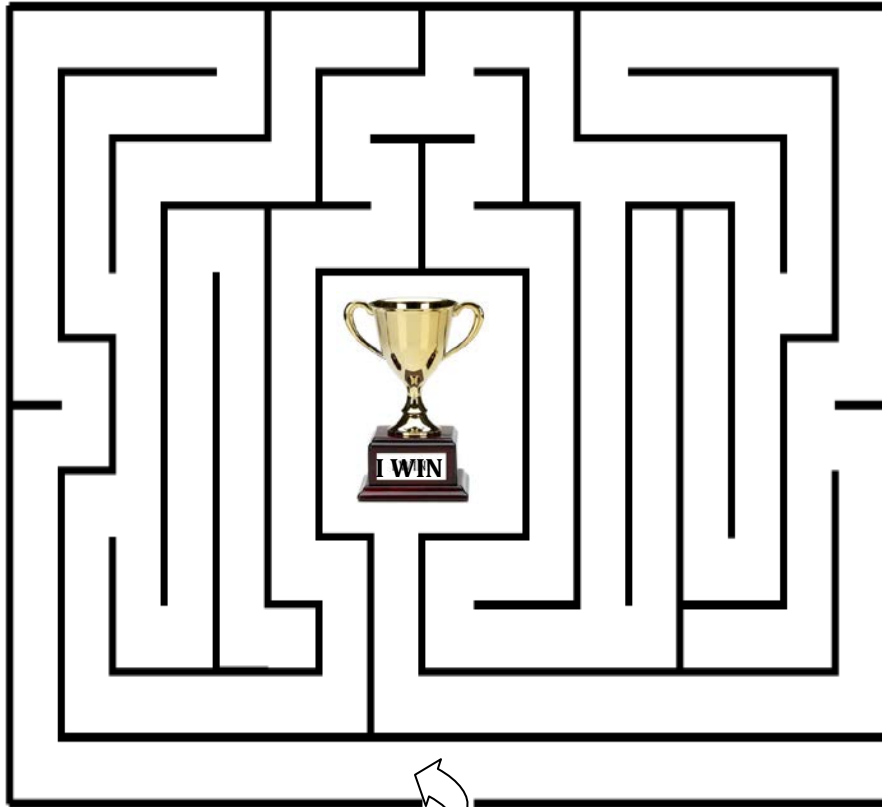


You are aMAZEing!!! You are already a winner. To get to your trophy, start at the arrow and go through the maze without crossing over the lines.

Gabrielle "Gabby" Douglas became the first African-American All-Around Olympic Gold Medalist, and the first female to win both all-around and team gold medals at the same Olympics when she was only 16 years



old. This great accomplishment didn't come easy for Gabby. She had several life challenges, faced criticism and racism but she did not stop pursuing her dream. She told Christian Post "you can achieve your dreams if you just trust and believe in yourself 100 percent. I went through hardships, struggles, homelessness and blood disease and all of those things, and I still accomplished my goals.
